Entry: Enter eligible boats by completing the attached entry form and submitting it prior to August 4, 2010, with the entry fee as indicated on the entry form.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions and frequency assignments will be sent to all competitors at the conclusion of the entry time period. Please be sure to include your email address on the entry form.

Racing format: Racing will be conducted under the EORS system. The race committee will determine the number of races for each day, after considering weather, course, and equipment conditions. To constitute the regatta, five races must be completed.

Scoring: The regatta will be scored in accordance with the Low-Point Scoring system, as set forth in Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing. For each five races sailed, each participant will be allowed one throw-out.

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the top five finishers in the regatta.

Measurements: Measurement and class authenticity verification may be conducted on site on a random basis, as determined by the Regatta Director, during check-in and registration.
