Directions to Laurel Acres Park:

Find the New Jersey Turnpike. Take it to Exit 4. After the tollbooth, stay to the right, which will put you on Route, 73 North. Stay in the right lane and turn right at the first traffic light, which is only about 100 yards. This will put you on Fellowship Road. Go to the second traffic light and turn right onto Gaither Road. There is a “Y” in the road. Stay to the left. Take Gaither to the end and turn Right onto Church Street. Stay on Church for about 1 mile and the park will be on your left. You’ll be able to find us from there.

All of these places are right around the intersection of Route 73 and Fellowship Road. It’s about 5 minutes to the park from this area.

Liberty Bell Sailing Instructions:

1. We are here to enjoy ourselves. Please keep this in perspective. We are a group of grown men playing with toy sailboats.
2. The Liberty Bell is a fleet racing regatta administered using Promotion/Relegation. This system will be explained at the skipper's meeting.
3. Penalty turns will be 360's in fleet racing.
4. Fleet racing....no dip starts. If you are over early, go around either end.
5. We still use a 2-minute tape for fleet racing. There may be a one-minute warning prior to the tape starting.
6. Protests not settled on the water will be taken to committee immediately. With that in mind, please also refer to instruction #1.
7. There will be no five-minute holds unless a burdened vessel damaged your boat.
8. Fleet racing throw-outs: One every eight races.
9. We will race until approx. 4pm on Saturday and 1pm on Sunday.
10. Refer to instruction #1 one last time. Good luck and have fun.
