1. Rules:

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The US Sailing Prescriptions to rule 60.3 is deleted.

2. Eligibility:

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to all EC12 owners and guests, who have an EC12 yacht and desire to compete.

3. Entry:

- 3.1 Competitors may enter by either registering on the AMYA web site using PayPal, or mailing an Entry Form with a \$20 entry fee, to be received no later than, July 5th, to Bill Tumlin, 5231 Rebel Rd., Marietta, GA 30068. After July 5th, a late registration fee of \$5 will be charged. Checks are to be made payable to: Bill Tumlin.
- 3.2 Registration fee includes Sunday lunch and After Race Social. Extra Guest Lunch is \$6.

4. Racing Format:

- 4.1 If more than 18 boats compete, racing will be conducted under the Equal Opportunity Racing System (EORS); otherwise all boats will start together.
- 4.2 The current National Seeding List will be used if heats are sailed.

5. Control Area:

- 5.1 AYC Viewing Pavilion and adjacent waterfront to the east. (same as 2016).

6. Schedule of Events:

- 6.1 0800 AYC Opens.
- 0945 Skippers' Meeting at AYC Viewing Pavilion.
- 1000 First Race; other races to follow. No race to start after 1530
- 1230 (approx) Lunch at AYC Viewing Pavilion.
- 1600 Awards ceremony and after race social.

7. Sailing Instructions (SI):

- 7.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers' Meeting

8. Scoring:

- 8.1 The Low Point Scoring System, as set forth by appendix A of the RRS, will apply. One(1) worst score, excluding penalty points, will be deducted from each Skippers' overall score for every eight (8) races sailed.

9. Awards:

- 9.1 Awards will be presented to the top three (3) Skippers.
