### 1. Rules:

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The US Sailing Prescriptions to rules 60.3 are deleted.

### 2. Eligibility:

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to all EC12 owners and guests who have an EC12 yacht and desire to compete.

### 3. Entry:

- 3.1 Competitors may enter by either registering on the AMYA web site using PayPal, or mailing an Entry Form with a \$45 entry fee, to be received no later than Friday, March 30, to Robert Mitchell, 513 Chestnut Walk, Canton, GA 30189. After March 30, a late registration fee of \$5 will be charged. Checks are to be made payable to: Bill Tumlin.
- 3.2 Extra Guest Meal package is \$30 (dinner only \$16). Registration fee and extra Guest Package include: Friday night welcome party and spaghetti dinner, Saturday and Sunday continental breakfast, Saturday and Sunday lunch, Saturday after the race social and dinner.

### 4. Racing Format:

- 4.1 If more than 18 boats compete, racing will be conducted under the Equal Opportunity Racing System (EORS); otherwise all boats will start together.
- 4.2 The current National Seeding List will be used if heats are sailed.
